	<p>Kenneth Harrington</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main Industry: Media • Inventor of Infomercial in 1985 and As Seen on TV • Founded Quantum International; Co-founded Home Shopping Network • Launched over 20 businesses that have grown to over \$100M each • Co-founder Entrepreneurs' Organization (EO)
	<p>Robert Herjavek</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main Industry: Software • Started his career working in the film industry then sold IBM computer equipment • Founded his first company, BRAK Systems—an Internet cybersecurity system integrator—in 1990 • Sold to AT&T in 2000 for \$30.2M
	<p>Daymond John</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main Industry: Apparel and Fashion • Mortgaged the family home to raise the capital to found FUBU in 1992 and raised over \$300,000 in revenue • Convinced L.L. Cool J to wear a FUBU tee shirt in a promotional campaign in 1993 • In 2016 FUBU was reported to be a \$6 Billion Dollar Brand
	<p>Kevin O'Leary</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main Industry: Software and Media • Obtained an MBA from University of Western Ontario then worked as an Assistant Brand Manager for Nabisco in the early 1980s • Co-founded Special Events Television Production Co. • Co-Founded SoftKey Software in 1986, which became a global educational software company after acquiring Compton New Media, The Learning Company, and Broderbund • SoftKey changed its name to The Learning Company and was acquired by Mattel in 1999.
